Video Transcript

Hi, my name is Jenny. I want to tell you a short story about how I got immersed in art and share some of my memories. I've been drawing since I was around 3 or 4 years old. I first initiated with a paper and a pencil to draw various subjects such as cartoons, cartoons from Disney movies, comic books, and animals. I'd trace them and draw from there. I've tried several new art methods - watercolour painting, acrylic painting, origami (paper folding), and so on. I couldn't stop drawing, persisting through an elementary school, high school and universities. So for my recollection, I recall a gallery being set up for deaf art students who displayed their artwork at my high school. I was one of them; I had some paintings and drawings being framed on the wall to exhibit to my friends and my family. That'd happened once every year. I now focus on digital painting, which means a subject is being painted or drawn on the computer. However, I still draw traditionally, only occasionally.
